'Woodwind Ensemble' - Melbourne Primary School Visit

The Music Department is running a collaborative event with Melbourne Primary School specifically involving pupils in the Woodwind Ensemble. The event will take the form of a workshop, where Woldgate School pupils will be visiting a Science lesson at Melbourne to help primary pupils learn about musical instruments and why different kinds of instruments produce different sounds.
